Early 20th century Europe was a caldron. Industrialization weakened some states and strengthened others; a million Europeans left their continent each year seeking better opportunities. Fervent, aggressive nationalists wielded power in many parts of the region. Monarchy as a system of government faced challenges everywhere. Early in the century Europe repeatedly flirted with a major conflagration, but had avoided it. In August of 1914, following another in a series of royal assassinations, the caldron finally boiled over. World War I began...100 years ago.
